WHERE IS MBAMBA

18°53'30" S 22°48'21" E

Mbamba is located in the northwestern region of Botswana on the NG12 concession, where the Okavango River begins to spread out, creating the world's largest inland delta. With a mix of floodplains, forested islands, lagoons and open grasslands, Mbamba offers a variety of stunning landscapes with enough ecosystem variation to support the full range of Okavango Delta wildlife.

An impressive range of mammals, birds, and reptiles, including rare and sought-after species can be spotted. Both lion and wild dog are in the area, and the seldom-sighted sable antelope is common. Even during the green season months of November through to March, big numbers of buffalo and elephant continue to be seen. The endangered wattled crane and the highly sought Pel's fishing owl are Okavango bird specialties that are often found here, along with a full diversity of birdlife.

WHEN IS A GOOD TIME TO GO

Mbamba is operational year round. Water levels are generally higher between April and October, and at other times of the year, water-based activities may be restricted.

Dry season: April – October

Green season: November – March

HOW DO I GET THERE

There are direct flights from Johannesburg and Cape Town to Maun in Botswana, where you will board a light aircraft for an air transfer to Xaraxai Airstrip, followed by a game drive to camp.

WHERE WILL I STAY

Accommodation is in 12 stylish canvas tents (4 doubles/6 twins/2 family units), each with an ensuite bathroom, indoor shower, standing fan, over-bed cooling system and private veranda.

WHAT WILL I EAT

Enjoy wholesome safari fare, surrounded by nature. Communal dining offers a relaxed setting for sharing stories and connecting with fellow travellers. Please inform reservations of any dietary requirements prior to travel.

FULLY INCLUSIVE RATE INCLUDES

Airstrip transfers, all meals, daily activities, local drinks and laundry are included. Flights, premium brand beverages, discretionary tips/gratuities, items of a personal nature and personal travel insurance are excluded.

WHAT ARE THE FACILITIES

The main H-shape mess area (to accommodate seating in different areas) includes 2 lounges and a small library with books, games, and a drinks cabinet. Dine under the stars or under canvas. Relax around the swimming pool in the heat of the day and star gaze around the firepit at night.

WHAT DO I NEED TO KNOW

- Solar power provides 24-hour electricity in the tents plus charging facilities.
- Wi-Fi is available in the rooms.
- We welcome children 6 years and older (please refer to our rate sheets for policies and pricing).



WHAT WILL I DO HERE?

Year Round:

- Morning and afternoon game drives.
- Enjoy incredible bird watching.
- Boating and mokoro safaris. *
- Fishing: 01 Mar - 31 Dec (no fishing permitted Jan - Feb due to breeding season).
- Helicopter flights over the Okavango Delta and to view ancient rock paintings. **
- Head out by helicopter on a community visit to meet with some of our community-based outreach partners **

** During low water season from Oct – Jan, mokoro & boating may be limited as these activities are subject to water levels.
