SHIPWRECK LODGE: FACTS & INFORMATION

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DESIGNED TO RESEMBLE THE SHIPWRECKS THAT LINE THE HAUNTINGLY BEAUTIFUL SKELETON COAST, SHIPWRECK LODGE IS ONE OF THE MOST UNIQUE AND DRAMATIC ON THE CONTINENT.

WHERE IS SHIPWRECK LODGE

Mowe Bay: 19°22'22.7"S 12°42'33.1"E

Shipwreck Lodge: 19°04'07.4"S 12°34'59.5"E

Shipwreck Lodge is the only lodge inside the Skeleton Coast National Park, 45km north of Mowe Bay, on the mouth of the Hoarusib River. The area contains irreplaceable and vulnerable wildlife habitat for species of the highest conservation importance, including black rhino, elephant, black faced impala and the Hartmann's mountain zebra.

WHEN IS A GOOD TIME TO GO

Shipwreck Lodge is open all year round.

Dry season: April – October

Green season: November – March

HOW DO I GET THERE

Direct flights to Windhoek from Cape Town, Johannesburg, Frankfurt, Amsterdam, Addis Ababa and Doha. Fly to Windhoek and then switch to a light aircraft to fly to Mowe Bay. Alternatively, there are road transfers available from Windhoek. Selfdrivers can make their way to Mowe Bay and from there, transfer to camp.

WHERE WILL I STAY

The 10 cabins (8 twins and 2 family with 2 rollaway beds) have been uniquely styled to look like the shipwrecks that dot the coast. All have standing fans and are ensuite (with indoor showers), inroom coffee machines, all are solar powered and have wood burning stoves to ward off the coastal chill.

FULLY INCLUSIVE RATE INCLUDES

Airstrip transfers, all meals, daily activities, local drinks, laundry and road transfers from Mowe Bay are included. Flights, premium brand beverages, discretionary tips/gratuities, items of a personal nature and personal travel insurance are excluded.

WHAT ARE THE FACILITIES

WHAT WILL I DO HERE?

Year Round:

- Sandboarding.
- Quad biking.
- Nature drives.
- Nature walks.
- Beach lunch (weather permitting).
- Sundowner drives to the roaring dunes.
- Day excursions to the Mowe Bay seal colony, including stops at the Suiderkus and Karimona shipwrecks, Westies diamond mine, and the remains of the Ventura Bomber.
- 1/2 day 4x4 Hoarusib River excursions, including the Clay Castles and wildlife spotting in the wet season.

*All ages welcome for these activities, although sandboarding is not advisable for young children 0-4 years.
Children from 16 years may quad bike. 1 pax per bike.*
