TULUDI: FACTS & INFORMATION

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AN INTIMATE, TENTED CAMP IN THE HEART OF THE GAME-RICH KHWAI PRIVATE RESERVE, TULUDI PROVIDES AN ICONIC OKAVANGO DELTA EXPERIENCE IN THE MOST REFINED AND SUPERBLY STYLISH OF SURROUNDINGS.

WHERE IS TULUDI

19°08'17.0"S 23°34'03.1"E

Tuludi is located in the 200,000 hectare Khwai Private Reserve that borders both the Moremi Game Reserve and Chobe National Park. Offering a rare blend of dry woodland as well as the rivers, waterways and floodplains iconic of the Okavango Delta, the area is a veritable paradise for wildlife and there are predators and big game aplenty. Game drives will primarily explore the western side of the reserve, whilst walks will head into the wilds of the south.

WHEN IS A GOOD TIME TO GO

Tuludi is open all year round with excellent game viewing. Water levels are highest in April to October for exploring on mokoros. At other times of year, water activities may be restricted.

Dry season: April – October

Green season: November – March

HOW DO I GET THERE

Tuludi is accessible from Maun and Kasane and any other camps in northern Botswana. Daily flights are available to Maun from Cape Town and Johannesburg. Fly to Maun and then switch to a light aircraft to fly to our private airstrip in the Khwai Private Reserve. From the private airstrip, you'll game drive straight into camp.

WHERE WILL I STAY

An intimate, exclusive camp, Tuludi has only 7 tented rooms – 6 twin/doubles and 1 family room with 2 additional single beds. Each is over 100 sq metres in size with a sunken, outdoor seating area with hanging basket chair and plunge pool, a separate dressing room, fans, and ensuite bathrooms with indoor & outdoor showers and bathtubs. Each room has over-bed cooling systems, with tea and coffee making facilities and a mini-bar.

FULLY INCLUSIVE RATE INCLUDES

Airstrip transfers, all meals, daily activities, local drinks and laundry are included. Excluded are flights, discretionary tips/gratuities, items of a personal nature, personal travel insurance.

WHAT WILL I EAT

Our wonderful chefs have a reputation for their good, wholesome meals. Please let us know of any dietary requirements prior to arrival.

WHAT ARE THE FACILITIES

The raised main area overlooks the iconic Delta floodplains with plenty of chairs and sofas to relax in. There is a separate dining area, firepit, large swimming pool and a treehouse library, 4 metres off the ground in the boughs of the trees. A new open-fronted gym is situated to the right off the pool deck. It has a treadmill, upright bike, weights & resistance bands plus yoga mats. The camp is solar-powered.

WHAT DO I NEED TO KNOW

- We welcome children 6 yrs and older; (please refer to our rates for child policies).
- Wi-Fi is available in the rooms and main area.
- Charging facilities in the main area and rooms.
- Hairdryers available in each room.
- Camp runs on solar power with 220v electricity.
- Our vehicles are open and accommodate 7 guests.



WHAT WILL I DO HERE?

Year Round:

- Morning & afternoon game drives.
- Helicopter flights over the Okavango Delta.*
- Mokoro safaris (water-level dependent).
- Fishing: 01 Mar - 31 Dec (no fishing permitted Jan - Feb due to breeding season).
- Be part of the KPR Ranger Experience and spend time tracking predators, capturing data, patrolling and if time allows visiting conservation projects. *(Proceeds of which will be allocated to conservation efforts in KPR).
- In-room spa treatments.*

Dry Season:

- Boating safaris (water-level dependent).
- Walking safaris**. (Only offered in the winter/drier months for better visibility.)

*At additional cost.

Children 16 years & older are welcome at Skybeds. If exclusive use is booked, then children between 12 - 15 years may participate, sharing a platform with an adult. Children 6 years & older may take part in a mokoro or boat safari and participate in the Ranger Experience. Children under 12 must wear a life jacket on a mokoro or boat.
