Grounded in the rare beauty of its natural surroundings and ancient history, Sarara's original camp brings the colours, textures, and spirit of Samburuland to life.

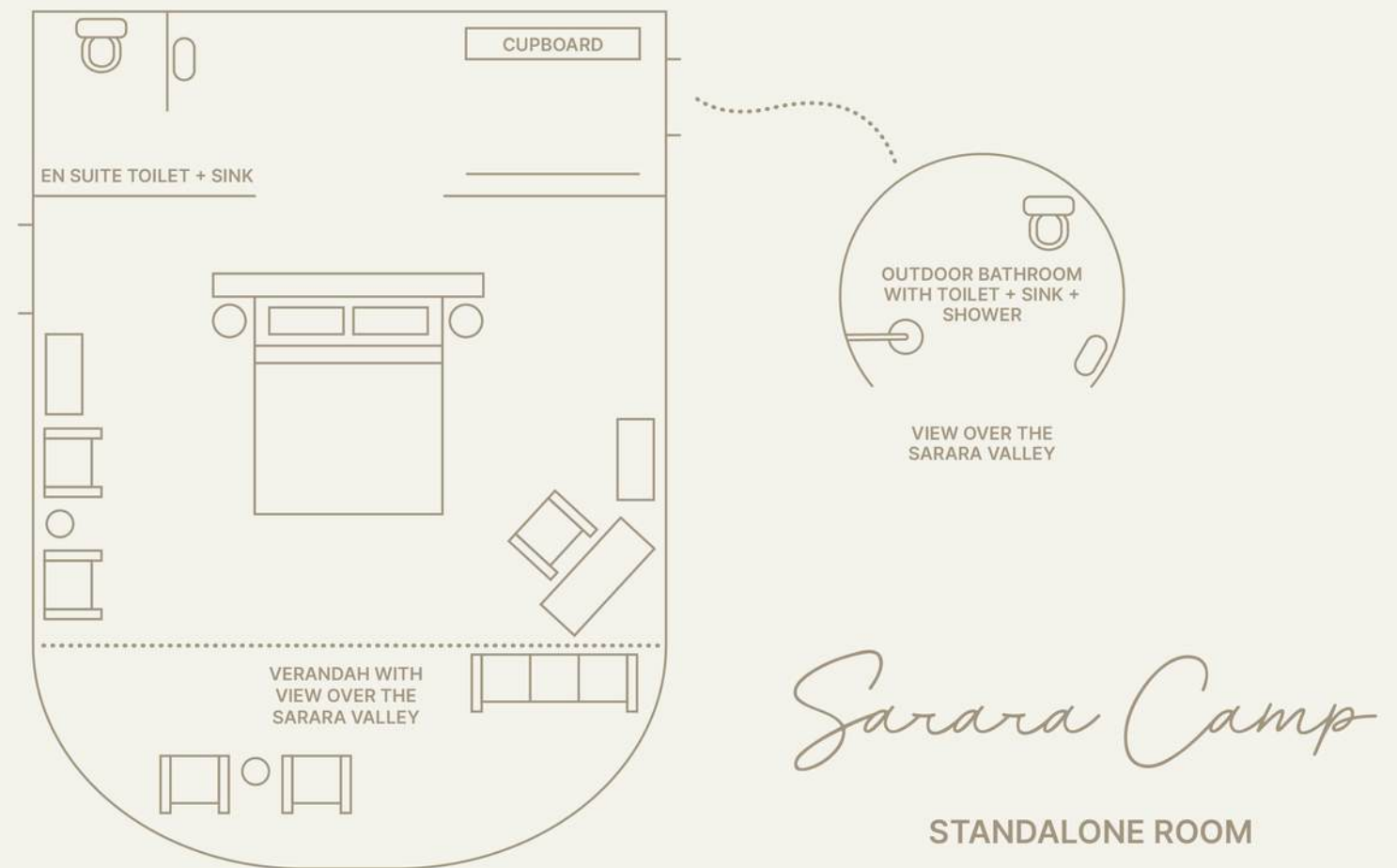

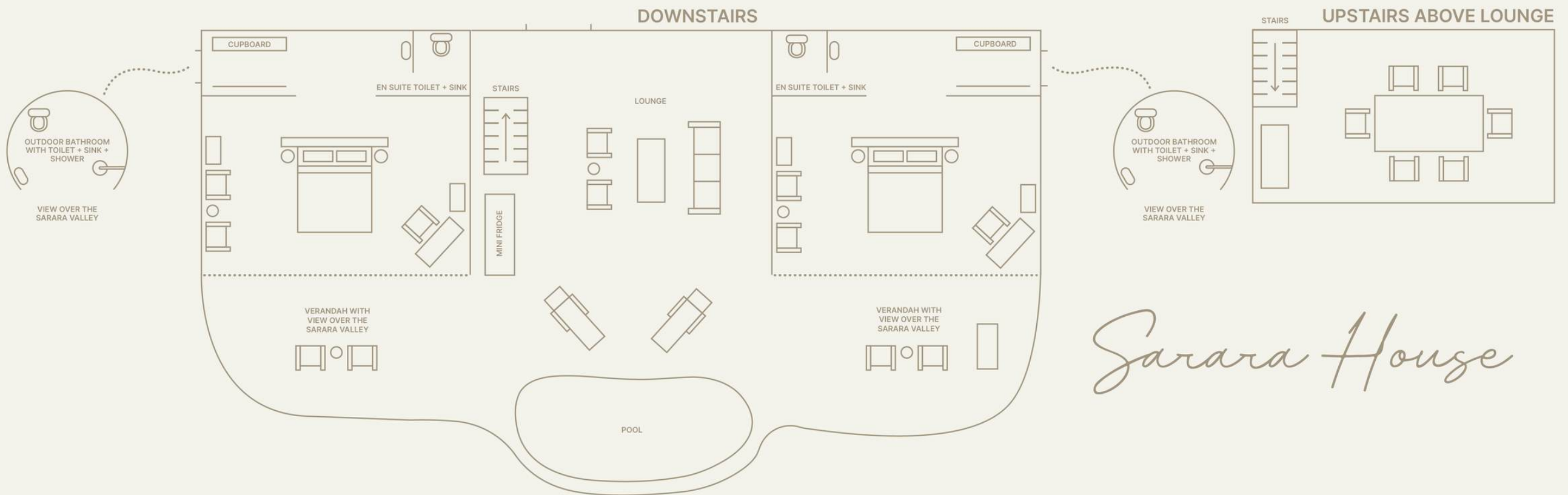


Sarara Camp also features the private retreat Sarara House

Sarara Treehouses

Tucked high into an ancient forest on the slopes of the Mathews Range, Sarara Treehouses is set within a lush green canopy.

Eight beautifully appointed tents are raised into the treeline and connected by stilted walkways, with elephants, buffalo, and other wildlife roaming the forest floor below. Each en-suite tent features a solar-heated outdoor shower and breathtaking views.

Reteti House

With its captivating cliffside setting and dramatic views, this exclusive-use lodge allows guests to experience the wilderness on their own terms. A spectacular central lounge and infinity pool overlook a busy elephant waterhole, and Reteti House lies just a stone's throw from Reteti Elephant Sanctuary.

There are four standalone suites with outdoor showers and private terraces, one open-plan family room with an indoor shower, and one family suite.

Sarara Wilderness

Nestled in one of Africa's last true wilderness areas, this magical under-canvas experience invites guests to create their own tailormade adventure while embracing the nostalgia of a classic tented camp in the heart of the bush.

Featuring six standalone tents, the camp also offers a splash pool, ice baths, expansive communal areas, and al fresco dining under the stars.

ELEPHANT SANCTUARY

Experience an extraordinary community and wildlife initiative during your stay

Reteti Elephant Sanctuary is the world's first Indigenous, community-owned African elephant sanctuary, with The Sarara Foundation (TSF) as its operating partner. Situated among Kenya's second-largest elephant population, the sanctuary cares for orphaned and abandoned elephant calves, with the aim of returning them to wild herds in the surrounding ecosystem. Since its launch in 2016, Reteti has become a flagship model for modern, community-based conservation alongside Sarara and Namunyak Conservancy.

POWER

24-hour solar power. Charging points are provided in the rooms (plug type G) at floor level and in the main area. No adapters are supplied.

The voltage of the sockets is not sufficient for hairdryers, but you will be able to charge your electronic devices.

ALTITUDE

The camp is approximately 800 metres above sea level.

TEMPERATURE

The region has a warm climate all year round, with nightly lows of 20–25 °C and daily highs of 30–35 °C.

GETTING THERE

Private charters into Namunyak Airstrip.

Scheduled flights with Safarilink or Air Kenya to Kalama.
Transfer: Kalama Airstrip (Northern Samburu) to Sarara – \$450 (maximum 4 passengers, approx. 1.5-hour drive).

Scheduled flights with Safarilink or Air Kenya to Lewa.
Transfer: Lewa to Sarara – \$550 (maximum 4 passengers, approx. 3.5-hour drive).

TO PLACE A PROVISIONAL BOOKING:

Your booking will be held provisionally for 14 days.

Bookings are accepted on the condition that guests have their own comprehensive travel insurance to cover all eventualities.

Bookings are confirmed upon receipt of a 20% non-refundable deposit.

The balance is payable in full 46 days prior to arrival.

The expiry date of your provisional booking will be noted on the reservation summary you receive. You are required to confirm the booking before this expiry date; otherwise, it will automatically lapse.

If you require additional time to confirm your booking, the expiry date may be extended once (on request).

TO CONFIRM A BOOKING:

A booking shall only be confirmed upon receipt of the 20% non-refundable deposit. Proof of comprehensive travel insurance is required.

The booking voucher should contain the following:

- Type of room you would like to book
- Date, time and method of guests' arrival and departure
- Number of people in the group and rooming requirements
- Names of all guests in the group and their ages
- Any dietary requirements or other special requests

In the event of cancellation:

Between 45 and 31 days prior to arrival, 50% of the full payment will be forfeited and 50% will be refunded. Cancellations within 30 days of arrival forfeit the full payment.

If travel is prevented by government- or pandemic-related travel restrictions within 45 days of arrival – either to Kenya or from the guests' home country – postponement of travel for up to 1 year is possible, subject to seasonal rates applying on the new dates.

Guests are required to complete a registration card on check-in.

Room check-out time is 10:00 am on the day of departure, and check-in is 11:00 am on the day of arrival.

We reserve the right to review published rates in the event of currency exchange rate fluctuations, or increases in costs or taxes that are beyond our control.
