Any additional children of this age will be charged 50% of the rate

Singles	<p>Single travellers and single-person room allocations are welcome at every Angama property, subject to the following conditions:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Subject to availability, in Standard Season, no single supplement shall be charged on the first two singles of any one reservation or combination of reservations for guests travelling together For reservations with more than two singles, each incremental single after the first two singles shall attract a supplemental charge of 50% of the applicable per person nightly rate In Peak Season months, a supplemental charge of 50% of the applicable per person nightly rate is applicable from the first single in any one reservation or combination of reservations.

Visa & Health Requirements	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Please ensure that you review the necessary visa and health requirements that are applicable for travelling to Kenya • Please consult your Doctor or Physician prior to travelling • Angama shall not be liable in any way if a guest fails to take the necessary medical precautions, or obtain the necessary visa or is denied entry into Kenya or quarantine on arrival for any reason whatsoever
Medical Evacuation & Health	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • All guests at Angama are covered by an insurance policy for evacuation due to a medical emergency, (of up to USD \$25,000) which would typically include evacuation by fixed-wing specialist aircraft directly from the closest airfield to the Angama lodge where they are staying i.e. Kichwa Tembo Airstrip and /or Kimana Airfield to Wilson Airport in Nairobi, and transfer to Nairobi Private Hospital • For your peace of mind, AMREF are the subcontracted transport providers. Additionally, the Kichwa Tembo Airstrip is one of the few airstrips in the Mara to be certified by AMREF for night evacuation flights • Guests staying at Angama Mara can be stabilised at the Angama Mara Clinic and evacuated at any time of day or night. Additionally, there are South Africa-qualified available over the phone should they be required. These services are provided by Africa Assist
Flights	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Scheduled Flights to the Maasai Mara Please note the scheduled services are shuttle flights with multiple stops enroute and require a minimum of four passengers in order to operate • Amboseli National Park Airstrip Please note the scheduled services are shuttle flights with multiple stops enroute and require a minimum of two passengers in order to operate • Scheduled Flights to Angama Kimana Airfield Please note the scheduled services are shuttle flights with multiple stops enroute and require a minimum of four passengers in order to operate <p>If you would like to ensure direct flights to and from the respective airstrips, without any stops, we would be glad to arrange a private flight for you. Baggage Allowances	<p>Please note that all scheduled internal flights carry a luggage restriction of 15kg/ 33lb per person in soft bags, including carry-ons. The acceptance of excess baggage is at the sole discretion of the airline but some offer the option to purchase an additional freight seat for luggage weighing up to 75kg/ 165lb.</p>
