MENO A KWENA: FACTS & INFORMATION

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A HIDDEN GEM OF A CAMP, MENO A KWENA IS PERCHED ON A ROCKY CLIFFTOP OVERLOOKING THE BOTETI RIVER WITH FRONT-ROW SEATS TO THE COMINGS AND GOINGS OF THE WILDLIFE BELOW.

WHERE IS MENO A KWENA

20°19'24.51"S 24°19'6.99"E

Located on the western boundary of Makgadikgadi Pans National Park (MPNP), Meno is situated on tribal land overlooking the exceptionally scenic Boteti River. The camp is easily accessible from Maun - approximately a 2 hours' drive.

WHEN IS A GOOD TIME TO GO

Meno a Kwena is open all year round. The zebra congregate at the river during the dry season (but this cannot be guaranteed!) and game viewing is excellent in all seasons.

The below is rough guide to the seasons, but in April/May and October/November, the weather is variable.

Dry season: April – October

Green season: November – March

HOW DO I GET THERE

Direct flights to Maun from Cape Town and Johannesburg. Meno a Kwena scheduled transfers depart Maun International Airport for camp at 14h00 and depart camp back to the airport at 10h00. The drive takes approximately 2 hours, mostly on tarred roads with 5 kms on gravel. Self-drive options are also available. Alternatively, fly from Maun to Leroo La Tau airstrip, a 40-minute drive from Meno.

WHERE WILL I STAY

There are 10 tents - 2 doubles (king size bed), 6 twins (2 queen size beds) and 2 family tents (1 family unit has 1 x King-size bed & 3 x singles, the other has 1 x King-size bed and 2 x 3/4 beds), all ensuite with indoor and outdoor showers. Tents have standing fans and are solar powered with lighting and international charging plugs.

WHAT WILL I EAT

The chefs at Meno a Kwena create good, wholesome food and all meals are prepared on an open fire. Please let us know of any dietary requirements prior to arrival.

FULLY INCLUSIVE RATE INCLUDES

Airstrip transfers, all meals, daily activities (incl the sleepout in a 3-night stay; must be pre-booked), local drinks and laundry are included. Flights, premium brand beverages, discretionary tips/gratuities, items of a personal nature, transfers from Maun and personal travel insurance are excluded.

WHAT ARE THE FACILITIES

The canvas lounge and dining tents are piled high with books, trinkets and artefacts, adding to the old-world feeling of the camp. There is a bar, library, refreshing, clifftop swimming pool and a floating hide.

WHAT DO I NEED TO KNOW

- We welcome children of all ages (please refer to our rates for child policies).
- Wi-Fi available in rooms only.
- Charging facilities available in rooms & main area.
- Vehicles are open and accommodate 7 guests.
- Please consult your doctor for recommended vaccinations.



WHAT WILL I DO HERE?

Year Round:

- Full day and half day game drives into Makgadikgadi Pans National Park.
- Cultural walks with the Kalahari Bushmen.
- Game viewing hide.
- Visits to the local communities. *On request.*
- Spa treatments. *At an additional cost.*

Green Season:

- Day trips to Nxai Pan. *On request.*

Dry Season:

- Boating on the Boteti. (Aug - Dec. Always water dependent.)
- Zebra migration. (Jun - Nov. Always weather dependent.)

Green Season:

- Sleep-out under the stars on the Pans.
- NB: this requires a minimum 3-night stay with a minimum of 2 guests. The sleepout can be done from 01 May to 30 September only and is subject to weather and dryness of the pans. Must be pre-booked.*

*Children of all ages may join the bushmen walks.
Children of all ages may partake in the boat safaris.*
