AS THE ONLY CAMP IN A VIRTUALLY UNTOUCHED 180 000-HECTARE PRIVATE CONCESSION, ON THE SOUTH-WESTERN SIDE OF THE OKAVANGO DELTA, THIS LITTLE CAMP IS ONE IN A MILLION.

WHERE IS MOKOLWANE

Mokolwane Camp is situated in the Xudum concession (NG29) on the south-western corner of the Okavango Delta and is one of the largest concessions in Botswana. It is a vast wilderness area of 180 000 hectares that is virtually untouched, and home to many species inhabiting crystal clear lagoons and channels, reeded islands and fertile floodplains.

WHEN IS A GOOD TIME TO GO

Game drives and scenic helicopter flights are possible year-round, with seasonal mokoro excursions on offer.

Dry season: April – October

Green season: November – March

HOW DO I GET THERE

Direct flights from Cape Town and Johannesburg to Maun, followed by a 30-minute helicopter transfer from Maun to the camp (the only means of access).

WHERE WILL I STAY

Mokolwane Camp is on the Matsebi river system and features wide open flood plains interspersed with Mokolwane palms, the favourite food of elephant and baboon. Charming guests with their simplicity, 7 comfortable tents (including 1 family room), lifted 10 feet above the ground, provide spectacular views of the plains and waterhole in front of camp. Surrounded by fig, jackalberry, wild mangosteen, and ilala palm trees, the comfortable rooms feature mosquito-netted beds, ceiling fans and occasional chairs. The ensuite bathrooms have double vanities and indoor showers.

WHAT WILL I EAT

Enjoy leisurely, wholesome meals in the communal dining area, watching the passing wildlife from the raised deck.

FULLY INCLUSIVE RATE INCLUDES

All meals, daily activities, local drinks, and laundry are included. Flights, premium brand beverages, discretionary tips/gratuities, items of a personal nature and personal travel insurance are excluded.

WHAT ARE THE FACILITIES

An elevated lounge and dining area where one can sit and watch the world go by, plus a firepit ideal for story-telling and exceptional stargazing. There is also a raised pool and deck, with loungers, overlooking the floodplain in front of camp.

WHAT DO I NEED TO KNOW

- Solar power provides 24-hour electricity in the tents plus charging facilities.
- Wi-Fi in the rooms.
- Our vehicles are open and accommodate 7 guests.
- We welcome children 6 years and older (please refer to our rate sheets for policies and pricing).



WHAT WILL I DO HERE?

- Enjoy morning and afternoon into evening game drives exploring the beautiful yet diverse ecosystems, looking for predators stalking the big herds.
- Boating and mokoro excursions.*
- Relax on your shady tent deck, coffee and binos in hand, looking for spectacular sightings that come close to camp.
- Ideal for bird lovers, there are plenty to tick off the list!
- With big open skies, enjoy incredible stargazing opportunities.
- Take a scenic helicopter flight over the Okavango Delta.**
