Tafika Camp's more remote location on the east bank of the Luangwa River, just north of the Nsefu Sector, makes it ideal for those who enjoy the serenity of the bush. Nestled under a canopy of giant leadwood and sausage trees, the camp provides stunning views of the river with ample opportunity to witness elephants crossing, hippos wallowing and kingfishers patiently pursuing their prey. Choosing a quiet spot to enjoy the view is an ideal way to relax between activities. The food is excellent and is supplemented by a wonderful supply of fresh salad, fruit and vegetables from the vegetable garden.



With six spacious chalets (including a family chalet and honeymoon suite) all built from natural materials, Tafika can accommodate up to 14 guests in a warm, friendly atmosphere. Built around the trunks of huge sausage trees, these thatched chalets all have running water, solar power and ensuite facilities with showers open to the stars.

From the camp guests can enjoy walking safaris in prime walking wilderness, unique cycling trails and day and night game drives. An in-camp hide, private Kawere hide and seasonal carmine bee-eater hide also offer great armchair game viewing up close. Cultural visits to nearby Mkasanga Village are on offer where the school is supported by Remote Africa Safaris' Tafika Fund in the form of books, educational materials, teachers' salaries and pupils' scholarships. Guests are always welcomed at Mkasanga with great enthusiasm and plenty of smiles and the church choir delights in the opportunity to serenade visitors with the harmonies of Africa.

Our game drives accommodate a maximum of four guests guaranteeing unobstructed viewing and enabling all guests on board to share in the knowledge and insights of the guide. With up to 470 species of birds, bird enthusiasts as well as the mammal lovers will become captivated by the array of feathered residents. The Luangwa is known as the *Valley of the Leopard*, so expect to see several of these spotted felines as well as lion, elephant, Thornicroft's giraffe (now a potential sub species of Masai giraffe and often referred to as Luangwa giraffe), herds of buffalo in their hundreds and wild dog. With the abundance of diverse game populations in the Nsefu sector of the South Luangwa National Park, and some of the most experienced guides in the Luangwa, Tafika Camp offers guests an unforgettable African safari.
